BEFORE WE BEGIN

YOU ALREADY DID THE HARD PART.

You said yes. That's the decision that matters most — everything from here is logistics. This guide walks through what to do before, during, and after your Gather, plus the exact language to use when the moment comes to make the ask.

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THE SHAPE OF A GATHER

BEFORE SHAPE, INVITE, PREPARE Pick a date and format, invite personally, review your materials.	DURING WELCOME AND ASK Host like yourself, then make a short, sincere ask.	AFTER HAND IT OFF Send us the details — we take it from there.
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BEFORE YOUR GATHER

Anytime after you sign up, through your event date.

1

SHAPE IT

Pick a date inside the campaign window, a format that feels realistic for you, and a guest list. Dinner at home, a table at your favorite restaurant, brunch, cocktails, game night — whatever you'd actually host.

2

INVITE

Reach out personally — a call, a text, a real invitation, not a mass email. Prioritize people who don't already know HMCKC. That's the whole point of Gather: you can open doors HMCKC can't open on its own.

3

PREPARE

Review this guide, your talking points, and your personal donation link or QR code. Nothing to memorize — just know where they are for the night of.

YOUR HOST EXPECTATIONS, IN FULL

- ☒ Confirm your interest and complete the host sign-up.

- ☒ Choose your date, location, format, and guest list.

- ☒ Invite people personally, with special attention to those who may not already know HMCKC.

- ☒ Use the HMCKC talking points to share who we are, why we sing, and why Gather matters.

- ☒ Give guests a clear opportunity to support HMCKC through your donation link or QR code.

- ☒ Share basic event and follow-up information with the Fund Development team.

- ☒ Help HMCKC thank your guests and welcome promising new connections into our community.

DURING YOUR GATHER

The night itself.

Welcome your guests. Let the evening feel like yours. At a natural pause — not a scheduled moment, just whenever conversation allows — say a little about why you invited everyone, then point them to your donation link or QR code.

THIS ISN'T A SPEECH

No presentation, no slides, no script to recite word for word.

SHORT IS RIGHT

A few sincere sentences land better than a polished pitch.

MAKE IT YOURS

Swap in your own reason for caring — that's what makes it work.

IF YOU WANT SOMETHING TO SAY

“I invited you because HMCKC has always been about more than what happens onstage. We use music to build community, celebrate pride, and create spaces where people can feel seen, welcomed, and connected. Gather is simply a way to bring more people into that circle. If that story speaks to you, I'd love for you to be part of it.”

Use it as written, or as a starting point — the version that sounds like you will always land better than the version that sounds rehearsed.

AFTER YOUR GATHER

Within a few days of your event.

- ☒ **REPORT BACK** Send attendance and follow-up notes to the Fund Development team.
- ☒ **FLAG CONNECTIONS** Tell us about guests who might welcome another point of contact with HMCKC.
- ☒ **HAND IT OFF** Gift collection, donor follow-up, reporting, and stewardship are ours from here.
- ☒ **STAY IN THE LOOP** We'll continue the relationship you helped begin.
- ☒ **BE THANKED** Expect a personal thank-you as campaign results and stories come together.
